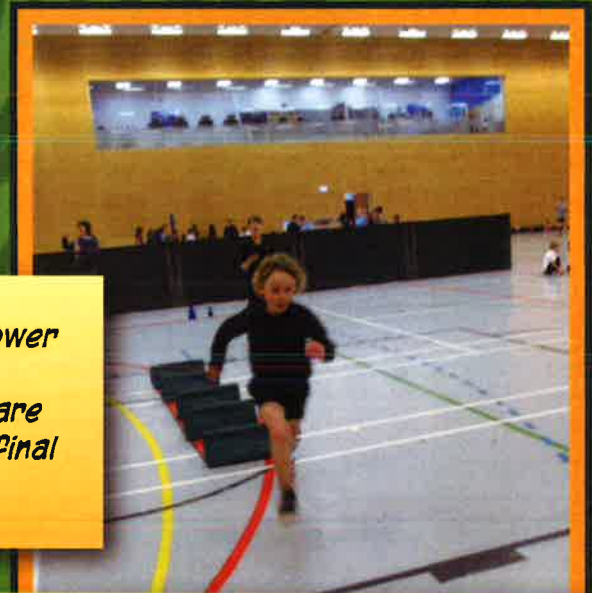
The teams competed in events which tested throwing, jumping, speed and teamwork. Watch out everyone next year, we will be back and there will be no stopping us!
