At The Firs, we believe that the care we give our children is our highest responsibility. We are very passionate about creating a nurturing and happy atmosphere where children thrive.

Beautiful Environment

The School is very proud to be part of the supportive Amptill community and our children very much enjoy learning and playing in our beautiful woodland setting.

High Quality Early Years Provision

The stimulating and exciting play environments in our settings follow the principles of best early years practice very carefully, to develop young learners, ensure they have a successful start to their time in school and make rapid progress. As it says in our recent Ofsted report 'Children in early years participate in high quality learning through their play'.

Read Write Inc.

As a Read, Write Inc. (RWI) school, we are passionate about children becoming fluent and successful readers. With assessments every 6 weeks and lessons taught at pace in small groups, we have always achieved consistent success, with the Y1 phonics test and in 2023 we achieved a 98% pass mark, placing us in the top 2% of Primary Schools in the country. Our recent Ofsted report comments that 'Leaders ensure that all pupils learn to read fluently'.

Engaging Curriculum

Whether it be learning a musical instrument, studying and emulating the style of an artist or learning about the Romans, our children enjoy a rich and diverse curriculum and 'a rich and varied range of broader experiences.' (Ofsted report March 23).

We are proud to be a Forest School and as well as the dedicated FS sessions pupils have each year, teachers use every opportunity to take the learning outside!

We offer a range of engaging extra curricular opportunities, such as learning a number of instruments through Inspiring Music, a diverse programme of after / before school clubs led by organisations such as Premier Sport and our hugely popular Saturday Morning Football, run by our dedicated parents.

We have a very active and supportive Parent, Teacher and Friends Association, who work tirelessly to organise events for our children and the whole school community to enjoy. They also raise much needed additional funds for the school that greatly benefit all our children.

Kids' Club
