Year 1 Birds of Prey Centre, Wednesday 1st July 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

Our science topic this term is the subject of 'Animals, including Humans'.

In order to support this subject and to give the children a suitable environment for outside learning we have booked a trip to the Birds of Prey Centre on Wednesday 1st July 2026 where the staff there will be engaging the children in a host of interesting activities such as meeting and handling an owl, meeting a variety of farm animals and watching a flying display.

We are asking for a contribution of £8.75 per child, payable through ParentPay by the 1st June 2026, which will include the cost of the coach and the entrance fee. As stated in the school prospectus, such contributions from parents are voluntary, however if a number of parents feel unable to make a contribution then the trip may not be able to go ahead.

We will require adult support for the trip, so please indicate when booking on ParentPay if you are able to help on the day. We would require any volunteers to be in school by 9.15 am to go through a risk assessment and to be given their groupings. We would expect to return to school by 2.30pm, traffic dependent.

The kitchen can provide every child with a universal free packed lunch. If you would like to take up this option, please indicate when booking on ParentPay. All lunch orders must be **completed by the 1st June 2026** to allow the kitchen to place their order in time. Alternatively, please provide your child with a healthy packed lunch in a named disposable bag (not containing fizzy drinks, food containing nuts or glass bottles please).
