Y2 READING BOOKS REMINDER

Our current system for exchanging reading books involves each child having been allocated a day that their books will be changed. Details of this allocated day were explained in a letter at the beginning of last half term. If you are unsure of the day your child is expected to be changing their books, please feel free to discuss this with the class teacher.

The children are receiving 3 books and have one whole week in which to read them. We hope they will read little and often; sometimes reading them more than once to gain a greater understanding of the story or practising with fluency and expression.

Just a reminder – Unfortunately, we have noticed that a number of children are not having their books changed as they are not being brought back to school. This subsequently means that we are unable to monitor their progress and are unaware of what they are completing at home.

Please could you therefore ensure, that the fish book and reading books are in school every day, particularly on their allotted day. It would also be helpful if you could sign your child's fishbook that week, so that we know that the books have been shared at home. The children will be given certificates as they read more and more books.
