3 30/4/18	<b>CLL</b> Shows interest in play with sounds, songs and rhymes (22-36m).  Joins in with repeated refrains and anticipates key events and phrases in rhymes and stories (30-50m).	Nursery rhymes.	To learn some well known nursery rhymes.	Singing nursery rhymes at home.	Castle
4 7/5/18	<b>Physical Development</b> Drinks well without spilling (22-36m)  Can usually manage washing and drying hands (30-50m)	Cooking royal biscuits.	Preparing for our banquet.	Talk about celebrations you have attended.	Royal Banquet
5 14/5/18	<b>Literacy - Writing</b> Distinguishes between the different marks they make (22-36m).  Sometimes gives meaning to marks as they draw and paint (30-50m).	Royal Wedding	To encourage mark making by writing invitations.  Encourage name writing for older children.	Writing party invitations.  Talk about the royal wedding. ie Who is getting married?	Palace
6 21/5/18	<b>PSED</b> Responds to the feelings and wishes of others (22-36m)  Enjoys the responsibility of carrying out small tasks. (30-50)	Becoming more Independent	To encourage children to be more independent.  School readiness.	Ask your child to help you with simple tasks at home.	School
