Year 3 Visit to Holdenby House

During the summer term, Year 3 have been studying World War Two as part of their History curriculum. In order to support and enhance their learning, there will be a visit to Holdenby House, where the children will participate in an 'evacuee day'. During their visit, the children will be taught about food rationing, 'make do and mend' and air raid shelters by different WW2 characters. The visit will take place on Friday 29th June during the school day. Please ensure children arrive promptly to school in the morning, as the coach will be leaving at 9:15am.

As the children will enter Holdenby House as evacuees, we ask that each child come dressed in typical World War 2 attire, including a gas mask box. The children will also need to bring their own packed lunch, snack and drink (no glass bottles) in a clearly labelled disposable bag.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.10 from each child. It is necessary to point out that due to budgetary constraints, it is essential that voluntary contributions cover the costs of the event and if a number of parents feel unable to make a contribution, this event will have to be cancelled.
