You are going to be in Pine Blue.

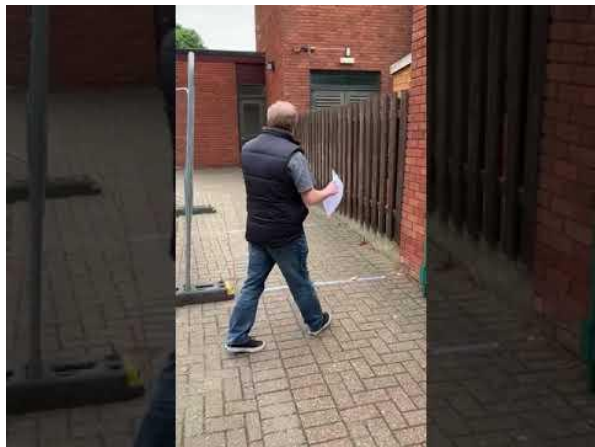
You will play in the Pine big room with Mrs Mercer and Mrs Ware.

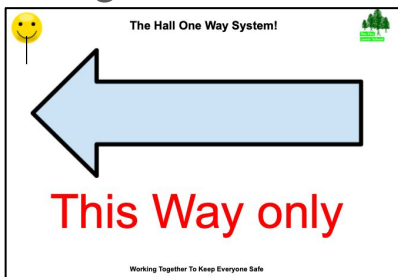


One way
