

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#### Arriving at school








People will be arriving at different times to help with social distancing. You need to get to school between 9:00 and 9:10.


Please come in through the gate from the car park into the courtyard. You will then go into school through the main school entrance.

If you have a lunch box, put it on the lunch trolley


You will need to wash your hands next. Your teachers will talk to you about how to wash your hands and when, we will be doing a lot of handwashing!


#### One way




A lot of the things in school will look very different at first, but you will get used to it!

#### Playtime and lunchtime


You will go out to morning play a 10:30 am.
