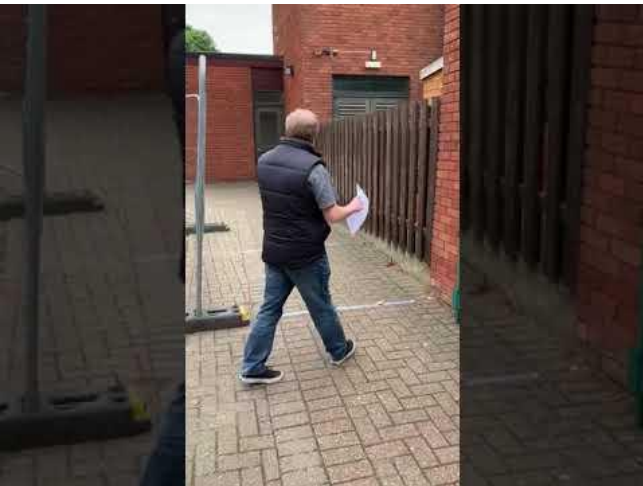

Arriving at school

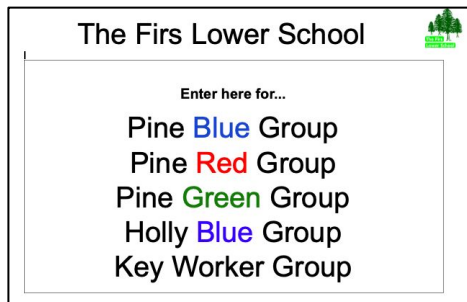


People will be arriving at different times to help with social distancing. You need to get to school between 9:00 and 9:10.

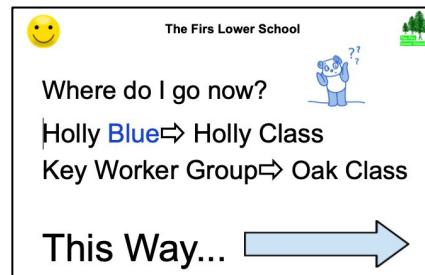
Please come in through the gate from the car park into the courtyard. You will then go into school through the main school entrance.

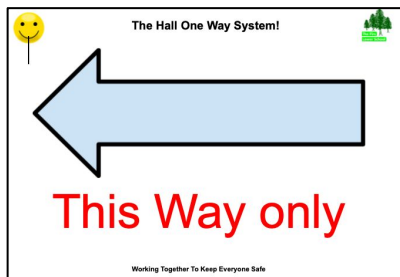
One way

Washing hands and Catching Sneezes!

Wash your hands carefully using soap for 20 seconds- sing Happy Birthday twice!

Home time
