Reading

We are in the process of assessing the children's reading to ensure that they are placed on the correct level of the reading scheme. Your child will be provided with a communication book (Fish Book) and 2 reading books of the correct level. The children will be responsible for changing their reading books and will be given a set day to do this. Once decided this day will be written in their Fish book to ensure you are aware of when your children should be bringing their reading books to school.

PE
