




Deciding whether to send your child to school flowchart

We are all living in difficult times at the moment and we are aware of how difficult it can be, in the current situation, to decide whether to send your child to school or not when they have cold / flu like symptoms.

With this newsletter, we have produced a flowchart which we hope will be useful to parents if they are confronted with this problem at some point this term. We hope it is of some use.



Dates for this term

You will not be surprised that there are less dates / events for the autumn term this year although there are some events that will be happening in a different and/or virtual way and we will be including a 'date' sheet with the newsletter next week.

Reduced Marking Trial

Like all schools, we are looking this year at ways to improve staff work/life balance, along with making sure time spent on providing feedback to children is done in the most effective way.

Often, we feel that staff write detailed comments for children in their books which, due to the need to read and understand them and the need for time to be provided to do this, the written feedback is not always as effective in moving children's learning on as we would like.

For this reason we are conducting a trial over the next 4 weeks where, for some lessons in English maths and science, teachers will look at pupil work after the lesson, making notes rather than marking each book individually. They will then plan a feedback session for the beginning of the next lesson e.g. picking up on misconceptions or next steps to build on what the children have already learned.

After half term, we will report back on how this trial went and the future plans we have for marking at The Firs

Pick up and drop off reminder

We would like to thank all the parents in Elm class for being so positive and patient after having to move their pick up/drop off slot. We have had a lot of feedback that both this change and the new layout in this area has helped the arrangements at the beginning and end of the day for Y4 and Elm class parents and we would like to thank all the parents for the feedback we have received.

It would be really appreciated if parents could make sure that they arrive/depart the school site **within the 10 minute window** for pick up and drop off, so that we can maximise the social distancing as much as possible. Thank you.
