

# The Firs Lower School Supporting Families over the Festive Period

#### **Parent Governor Vacancy**

We have 3 nominations for a parent governor and we have only one vacancy and will therefore have to have a ballot. Some parents have understandably enquired about the possibility of using online approaches for the ballot. Unfortunately, we have consulted our 'Articles of Association', which is our operating document, set for us by the Dfe as an academy. In this document it explicitly states that the process must be conducted using paper ballots. Therefore, all the children will be bringing home 2 copies of the ballot paper and personal statements from the parent governor nominations, so that each parent can place their vote and put it in a sealed envelope for the attention of the headteacher.
