## Covid Case in Year 2-21/5/21

As we have reported already today, following local public health advice, we have needed to send home some of our Y 2 children as a precaution today, after a child had two positive lateral flow test results.

We are waiting for a confirmatory PCR result and we are hoping we might hear something over the weekend. Whenever we do hear, we will update all parents via text message.

If the PCR test is positive, then the Y 2 children affected will need to continue to isolate for the full 10 day period and $Y 2$ staff will organise remote learning via Google Classroom from Monday.

If the PCR test is negative then all the children will be able to cease the self isolation and will be able to return to school normally.
