

New One Way System

Thank you to all our parents / carers for their support and patience as everyone gets used to the new one way system. We hope that it is an improvement on the old system (that involved parents struggling against the 'tide' of incoming parents when they wanted to exit the site with their child.

There are just a couple of points that we would like to update you on / ask for your help with:

- 1. We are aware that some parents have been queuing on station road which is obviously inconvenient for the parents / carers involved and causes a sizeable obstruction along the pavement. As we return to normal, there is no need to queue and we would invite parents to walk through one of the two entrances and wait in the courtyard for the Station road gate to be opened. Thank you.
- 2. Could Beech and Elm parents / carers please exit round the outside of the Y3 block, following the red signs, after picking up children. The route through the Y4 corridor is only for Y4 parents and Willow class staff are finding it hard to keep their children safe and do a proper handover with lots of other parents coming through the door into the corridor- thank you.

KS1 Reading Books

From next week, we will be reverting to the system, for changing reading books, that we had in place before Covid.

Year 1

- From Tuesday 14th reading books will be available in boxes under the Y1 shelter (just outside the classrooms)
- They will be made available to parents / carers every day from Tuesday onwards.
- The books will be out am only, the idea being that the book is changed on drop off.

Year 2

- From Monday 13th, reading books will be available in boxes just outside the Y2 classrooms
- They will be made available to parents / carers every day.
- The books will be out am only, the idea being that the book is changed on drop off.

If you are unable to change books at this time, just let your class teacher know and they will help you.

Children in Year 3 and Year 4 will change their own book during the school day.

Staff Car Park and Service Road

We would like to remind parents that our staff car park is for use by our staff, Saplings and Kids' Club parents dropping off and picking up from Kids' Club and Saplings only. Please collect your parking permits from Kids' Club or Saplings and display this on your dash board.

If you or your child has a disability and needs to use our car park, please come to the office for a parking permit.

If you do not have a parking permit, you will not be able to use our car park. Our car park and service road can get very busy which makes this a very dangerous place when children are around. Please do not park or use the service road unless you have a parking permit - thank you for helping us to keep everyone safe..
