## Y1 Trip to Woburn Safari Park, Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2022

We would like to inform you about an exciting trip we are planning for the children next half term to Woburn Safari Park. This links to our science topic about the identifying and classification of animals.

We will be visiting Woburn Safari park on **Tuesday 14th June**. The children will be involved in an action packed day, leaving school at 9:15am prompt, straight after registration so the children will need to be in school by 8:55am as normal. Children will be travelling by coach and will return by 3.30pm

We are asking for a contribution of £15.60 per child which will include: the cost of the coach; the entrance fee and an enhanced education session. As stated in the school prospectus, such contributions from parents are voluntary, however if a number of parents feel unable to make a contribution then the trip may not be able to go ahead. Please access your ParentPay account to confirm your child's attendance by the 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

Please provide your child with a healthy packed lunch in a named disposable bag so that they do not have to carry lunchboxes all day (not containing fizzy drinks, food containing nuts or glass bottles please).

The children are required to wear school uniform on the day but may wear trainers or other sturdy, comfortable footwear instead of their school shoes. They will also require a bottle of water, a waterproof jacket, a sun hat and a small backpack to hold their lunch, drink and waterproof as they will be carrying it themselves all day.

We would like some parent helpers to accompany us on the trip and be responsible for a group of children. If you would like to volunteer, please indicate on ParentPay when you are making your Payment. If we have too many offers of help we will draw out names randomly. We would like to thank you in advance for your support as trips like these would not be possible without your help.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding the trip, please feel free to speak to your child's teacher.
