## High Quality Early Years Provision

We have created stimulating and exciting play environments in our settings, which follow the principles of best early years practice very carefully, to develop young learners, ensure they have a successful start to their time in school and make rapid progress.

## Read Write Inc.

As a Read, Write Inc. (RWI) school, we are passionate about children becoming fluent and successful readers. With assessments every 6 weeks and lessons taught at pace in small groups, we have achieved consistent success, with a 96% pass mark in the Y1 phonics test, in 2018 and 2019, placing us in the top 7% of primary schools in the country. We were very proud that our our children sill achieved 91% in 2022, despite Covid disruption.

## Engaging Curriculum

Whether it be learning a musical instrument, studying and emulating the style of an artist or learning about the Romans, our children enjoy a rich and diverse curriculum.

We are proud to be a Forest School and as well as the dedicated FS sessions pupils have each year, teachers use every opportunity to take the learning outside!

We offer a range of engaging extra curricular opportunities, such as music lessons in a number of instruments through Inspiring music, a diverse programme of after and before school clubs led by organisations such as Premier Sport and our hugely popular Saturday Morning Football, run by our dedicated parents.

## PTFA

We have a very active and supportive Parent, Teacher and Friends Association, who work tirelessly to organise events for our children and the whole school community to enjoy. They also raise much needed additional funds for the school that greatly benefit all our children.

## Kids' Club
