

Ho ho ho, Merry Christmas!

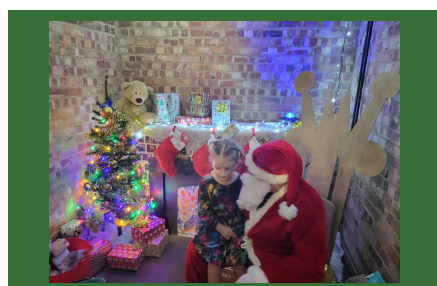
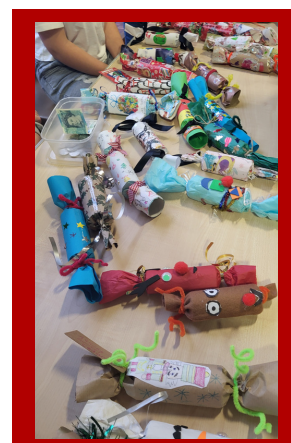
