

Leading up to our celebration of World Book Day later this term, we will be holding a book fair in school after half term.


The Book Fair sessions will be on the following dates after school (3:45 - 4:15)

For all children of the Firs Lower School and Saplings Pre-school aged 3 years old and over, we are offering the following sessions:-


- Full Days (9.00am 4.00pm) for £31.50
