### **Men's Tour of Britain Cycle Race on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September**

Central Beds is hosting stage three of the race, which will begin in Milton Keynes, travel through Central Beds, and finish on Woburn Street in Ampthill. The route will enter Central Bedfordshire via Woburn and Aspley Heath, head south past Toddington, pass through Barton-le-Clay, then cross to Broom and circle Old Warden, before continuing past Haynes, on its way to a sprint finish in Ampthill.

Please note that the main gate will only be open from 1.30 – 1.40pm and the Y4 gate will be closed at 1.45pm. We would kindly ask that you are prompt with the pickup and also with leaving the building. We need to ensure that the site is secure for the remainder of the afternoon, so your co-operation with this will be greatly appreciated.
